On July 8, SSIS students will exercise their right to vote for the student leaders who will govern the Student Council for the school year 2011-2012.

As it is in real elections, they will line up to see their names in the list of voters and affix their signatures, shade the circles corresponding to their favored candidates in the ballots, and have their fingers marked with indelible ink.

The student council is a representative structure through which students can become involved in the affairs of the school, working in partnership with the school management, teachers, staff and parents to achieve the organization's mission and vision.

Campaign period starts on July 1 and ends on July 7. To date, campaign materials are already visible.

SSIS PERSONNEL GAINS FIREFIGHTING SKILLS

SSIS teachers and administrative personnel completed the three-day Competency Training for the Fire Brigade given by the Bureau of Fire Protection of Batangas City on June 23-25, 2011.

The first day of the program focused on lectures about the types of fire, causes and prevention, the stages of fire, the firefighting basics and firefighting tools. The participants were also trained on how to use the fire extinguisher by putting out the fire emanating from a liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) tank.

On the second day, they tackled the medical aspects involved in fire rescue like first aid and CPR. They learned how to tie ropes which are important tools in rescue. A simple rescue simulation was also held.

The third day was the climax as they had to carry the hose, crawl on the gravelly parking lot and wet themselves as part of the culminating activity. In that simulation,

they had to apply the concepts and skills gained from the lectures.

SSIS is the second school in Batangas to receive such training. The new members of the fire brigade were very grateful for the experience as it equipped them with the essential skills in saving lives. Nurse Cy echoed the training to the teachers and staff during the LIP.

PARENTING CORNER

5 Simple Ways Kids Can Help the Environment

ECO-COOK .Make local foods the centerpiece of your dinners this month. Let your kids help you check for specially labeled items at your grocery store, or, better still, head for the farmers market.

COMPOST .See how to turn your leftover food scraps and yard waste into nutrient-rich soil for your veggie and flower gardens at EPA.gov (search "compost").

WATCH .Learn about environmental issues through films like *Wall-E* or, for bigger kids, the PG-rated *An Inconvenient Truth*.

SURF .Show your child that saving the environment can be fun by playing games such as Barney and Friends Clean Up (Pbskids.org/games/environment.html). Older kids will enjoy Adventures With Bobby Bigfoot (Kidsfootprint.org).

MAKE .Instead of dumping a plastic milk jug in the recycling bin, turn it into a bird feeder. Cut a strip out of the side opposite the handle, fill it with birdseed, and set it on a flat rock or other protected spot.
