Everyone is looking forward to an exciting Academic Year 2011-2012 marked by a rebirth of what is TRUE, GOOD, and BEAUTIFUL in all of us as reflected in this year's theme "Understanding the Humanity Within through the 5Cs (Competence, Character, Collaboration, Commitment and Creativity)." Policy on Fetcher's Pass

Parents/fetchers are required to secure a fetcher's ID from the Administrative Office and submit it together with 2x2 ID pictures of the fetchers.

The fetchers are expected to fetch their children promptly. They must wear proper clothes (no shorts and boxers) with fetcher's ID and must observe proper decorum when inside the school premises.

Parents must inform the office if their children will be fetched late. Children will not be released to an unauthorized person. The office must be duly informed in writing if someone other than the parents or the authorized fetcher will fetch the child from school.
