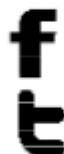

SSIS Holds Moving Museum featuring Dance Festivals

Stonyhurst Southville International School-Malarayat Campus will hold its annual Global Month Culmination Activity (GMCA) on **Thursday, October 26, 2017** (re-scheduled from October 23). This year's GMCA is the **Moving Museum** with the theme: "Dance with the Kings!"

On October 26, ECED students will have their Moving Museum at 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. Grade School, Junior High School, and Senior High School students will do their presentations shortly after the ECED Moving Museum.

Guidelines for the Moving Museum

- Each class will re-enact a dance festival of their country. Festivals will be assigned to them.
- The class will show a dance for 16-32 counts before freezing to place.
- Assigned students will act as their class curator and will say something about each dance festival. They keep frozen for 30 seconds after the curator finishes his/her piece.
- The introduction/explanation of the dance should be 1-3 sentences only.
- The chairman of the board of judges will give the adviser the cue when the judging of their class is done.
- One winner per department will be announced.
